ISA Activity - VISIT TO COTTAGE INDUSTRY :

Students of Bawa-Lalvani Public School visited “Jagdambay Industry” under British Council International School Award Project on 6th January, 2016. The industry produces high quality mattresses. The Mattress production process is a complex one as it passes through several phases which includes melting of plastic with the help of butane and propane in the presence of cooking (LOD) gas, which is followed by cooling of it and the



formation of plastic crystals. Then, these plastic crystals are converted into thin sheets of EP foam, which are stored in the godowns for about 25 days so that the gas could release. Otherwise, it would catch fire. After a long wait of 25 days, these sheets are compiled and covered with computer designed cloth. All this process, result in the formation of mattress. In the end, the mattresses are packed with plastic and labels are added to it. It was a pleasure to visit the industry. It was a great learning experience for all.

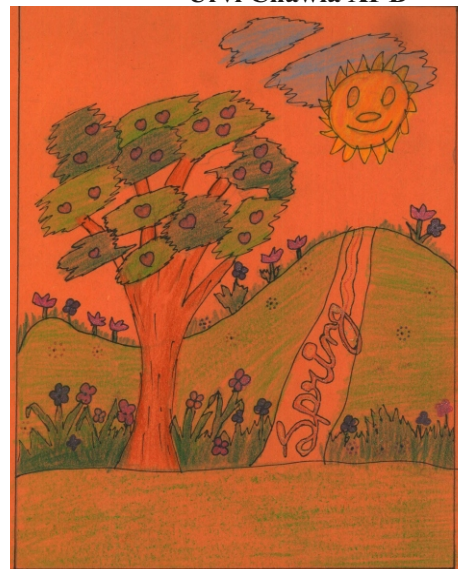
1. Student birthday parties/goodies distribution will not be held at school during the school time.
