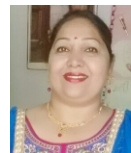

## Solo Dance Competition:

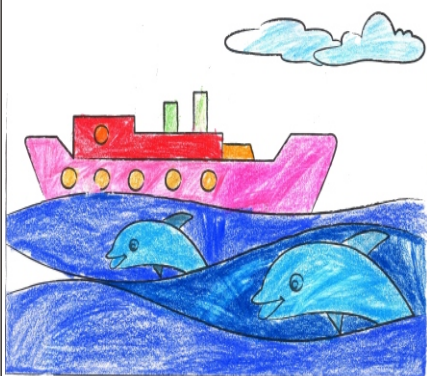
