## Lending A Hand



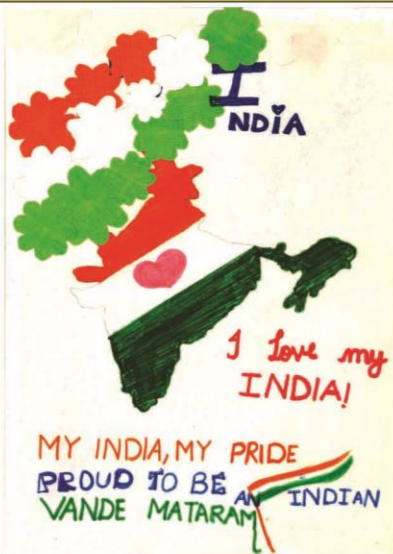

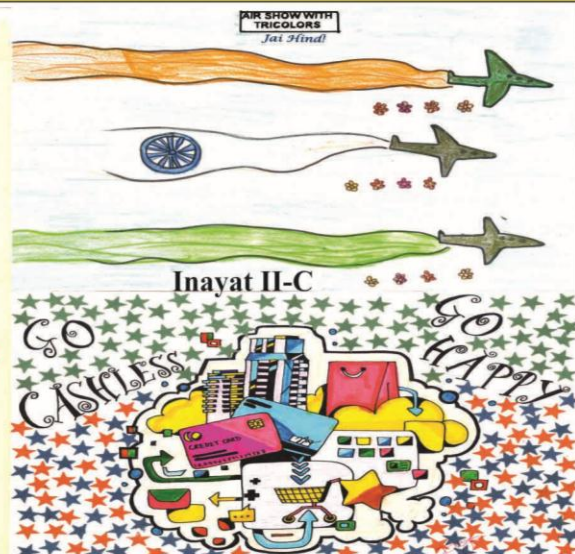
## Song of the Month
