### Visit to Fun Factory:

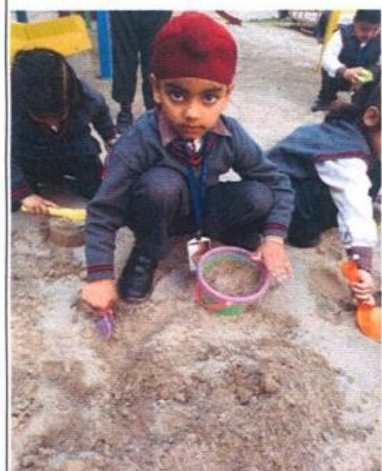

They help to build background knowledge and vocabulary and are important for success in school and life. “All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy”. Play invites creativity and collaboration and can inspire children to think out of the box. BLPIANS of KG2 went to Fun Factory Urban Estate Jalandhar for an enriching day outing. They enjoyed rides, going through tunnels and participated in fun games.



### Sand Pit Activity:

**Sand Pit :-** Sand play is an ideal opportunity to develop the minds and bodies of children. Most importantly, children consider this play as a great learning experience. Muscles in the arms and upper bodies of children are developed further through sand play. By playing together in a common space, children learn empathy, cooperation and sharing. Playing with containers of varying sizes and shapes help to teach children about concepts like “more than, less than and equal to”.





## Outdoor Games:



**Outdoor Games :-** Physical development means development of both fine and gross motor skills. When you use larger muscles during activities such as jumping, sliding, running gross motor skills development is done. In BLPS Kindergarten, we teach our children the ways to walk, climb and run. They also hop and jump a few low steps, alternate their feet while climbing. They learn to avoid obstacles, run at a pace that is even and walk forwards & backwards without watching their steps. Balancing will also be easy for children.



**Fireless Cooking :-** Kids learn by exploring with their senses and kitchen is an ideal place to do that. Kindergartners love to show what they can do and working in the kitchen provides opportunities to gain a sense of accomplishment. Cooking help young kids learn and practice some basic math concepts and build language skills with the new vocabulary. The experience



of creating meals can help build their self-confidence and lay the foundation for healthy eating habits.

## Learning By Doing:

**Learning by Doing :-** Playing is one of the main ways through which children learn. It helps to build self worth by giving a child a sense of his or her own abilities and to feel good about themselves. Young children are learning and developing quickly. Organised activities help develop their learning in an informal setting. In turn, this is preparing them for more formal school life.
