We feel proud to be a part of this school and pray to god for the success of the school.

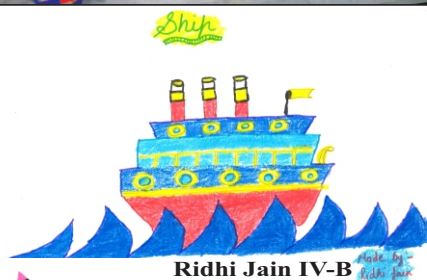

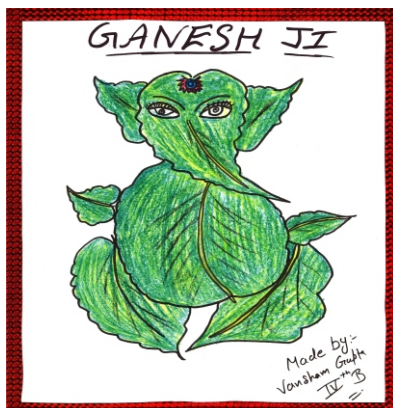

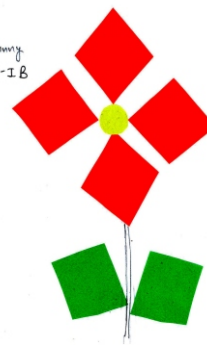
