The KG, Primary & Sr. Secondary wing were well managed during the session 2019-2020. The school has crafted the testing systems/ examinations and evaluation pattern as per the new instructions of CBSE. This will mean having less number of examinations in the school during the session.

Board Result 2019-2020

Our 82 students appeared in CBSE Grade XII Board Examinations 2020 have achieved remarkable results. The school stood out by achieving 100% pass percentage. The highest percentage scored by Simran Singh (Medical) (96.8%), Navjeet Kaur (Non Medical) (96.2%), Lovleen Kaur (Commerce) (96.4%) & Yamini Sharma (Humanities) (95.6%). Ten students secured a perfect 100 in various subjects. 37 students have secured DISTINCTION with scores in excess of 90 % marks. 30 students have secured between 80-89 % marks. 13 students have secured between 70-79 % marks. 2 students have secured more than 60-69 % marks.

Our Std 10 Class of 2020 , comprising 75 students have once again achieved 100% results in the CBSE Board Examinations 2020, declared on 15th July 2020.
