The academic session 2024–2025 has been a vibrant and progressive year across all wings—Kindergarten, Primary, and Senior Secondary. In alignment with the latest CBSE guidelines, the school has proactively restructured its examination and evaluation framework. Emphasis is now placed on conceptual clarity, competency-based learning, and progressive assessments, ensuring minimal pressure while maximising retention and application. With fewer formal examinations and greater focus on continuous academic engagement, learners experience education as a joyful, meaningful process rather than a series of tests. The refined system not only enhances understanding but also fosters independent thinking and lifelong learning habits.

BOARD EXAMINATION ANALYSIS – SESSION 2024–25

The academic session 2024–25 has brought yet another year of pride and excellence to Bawa Lalvani Public School with exceptional performance by students in the CBSE Board Examinations. In Form XII, a total of 57 students appeared, all of whom passed with flying colours. A remarkable 19 students scored within the 90–100% range, while 28 students secured marks between 80–89%, indicating that over 82% of the cohort achieved distinctions. The highest percentage recorded was an impressive 98.4%, reflecting academic excellence at its peak. Moreover, 21 perfect scores of 100 were achieved across subjects such as Painting, Music, Mathematics, English, Economics, and Accountancy, clearly demonstrating the students' subject mastery and the effectiveness of the school's academic mentorship.

The performance of Form X was equally outstanding. Out of 68 students, 26 students achieved scores between 90–100%, and 23 students fell within the 80–89% bracket. The highest percentage recorded was 98%, with 11 perfect scores of 100 in subjects, further emphasizing the school’s focus on academic rigour and conceptual clarity from the foundational level. Notably, no student scored below 60% in either class, and there were no EIOP or NIOP cases reported, underscoring the school's consistent 100% pass rate.

The strong performance across both senior and secondary levels reflects a deep-rooted academic culture nurtured through structured guidance, quality teaching, and remedial support systems. This achievement is a result of dedicated efforts by students, continuous parental support, and the school’s unwavering commitment to educational excellence. As these students move forward, they carry with them the values of perseverance, discipline, and confidence instilled by their alma mater.
