Students were mandated to propose actionable ideas for an eco-friendly Holi celebration. Team BLPS suggested that instead of opting for damaging synthetic colors, it is best to celebrate Holi using natural colors – use organic gulal or mix turmeric and floral extracts in various combinations to DIY the process. Such colors can be safely removed and do not damage the hair and skin. Rehaan secured GOLD, Dhanvi secured SILVER, while Rashmeet bagged BRONZE.
