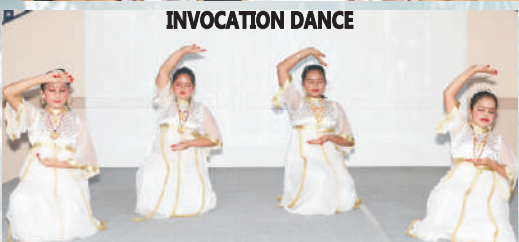

The theme selected for the contest was dedicated to 550th Birth Anniversary of Baba Nanak, titled "Prophet Nanak & his Teachings". The chief purpose of this contest was to generate awareness and enhance knowledge about Baba Nanak's Teachings & Philosophy.



With the aim to recognize talents of the budding cartoonists, the school conducted Inter House Cartoon Character Making Competition. The theme of the competition was "Popular Cartoon Characters". Students studying in Std. I to IV participated in the contest.
