Q4. What comes before Wednesday?

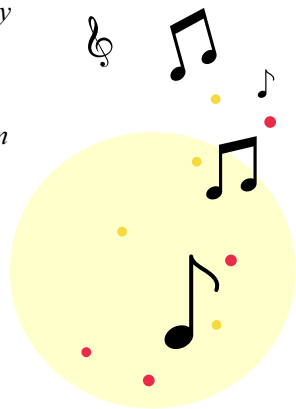
A4. Tuesday comes before Wednesday.
