Our School provides a rigorous, academically challenging and balanced program of education designed to prepare students aged 3 yrs to 17 yrs for success at university, and life beyond. Our **Kindergarten years** follow the Montessori program. This curriculum is based upon four themes & principles:

- Learning and development Children develop and learn in different ways. The framework covers the education and care of all children in early years' provision, including differently abled children with special educational needs.

Our **Primary Wing** follows a well curated CBSE assigned system and ensures that students moving to Middle school have an easy transition with the demands of the curriculum. We believe that all students should benefit from the rich experiences that life in India provides and have adapted the curriculum to maximize the opportunities which exist here. A strong emphasis on honesty, pride and integrity is amalgamated with the school Learner Profile attributes. With our strong well-defined curriculum, students grow into being well-rounded, happy and responsible people.



Our Middle Years, including Grade 6, 7 and 8, help to ensure successful transitions from Primary to Secondary. The program is delivered through NEP 2020 curriculum which offers inspirational learning experiences through cross curricular projects, cross phase learning and a challenging mastery approach. Meaningful links are made to the real world and students are encouraged to be independent learners, confident problem solvers and responsible global citizens. CURRICULUM

BLPS is a community of learners. Students and staff grow together as they experience gifts of our community. Teaching and learning at BLPS encourages an attitude of open enquiry which lasts a lifetime.

Our NEP 2020 based curriculum is broadly defined, including academics & enrichment. It is our educational philosophy (We believe education is about 'Soul-Making' - shaping young lives, confronting the destructive modern patterns of materialism and self centeredness and showing young people how to live what ancient philosophers called the 'Good Life') that those students who participate fully in holistic learning are best prepared to live meaningful, successful lives, and are equipped to make significant contributions to the world around them.

In keeping with this approach, our learning outcomes for the whole community are broad and challenging. BLPS is a CBSE School awarded the British Council International School Award, offering an inquiry- and standards-based approach in the Kindergarten Years, the Middle & Secondary Years Programme with selection of special subjects as per aptitude in Grades 11 and 12.





OUR CLASSROOMS



Our admissions policy requires parents to declare if their child has any special learning needs. If it becomes known that such needs were not disclosed, the school reserves the right to not admit the child. In case it is discovered after admission and we are unable to support the learning needs, the school reserves the right to review the student continuing their education here, in the best interest of the student. Our stimulating and supportive environment enables students to foster a passion for learning that helps them develop high aspirations and a lifetime of memories.

Blended Learning at BLPS: Catering to the present unique scenario, new systems, protocols and timetables have been created and communicated to all students and parents. Our blended lessons cater simultaneously for students inside the classroom and at home through live streaming. All classrooms have speakers and microphones offering an immersive experience to those learning from home. Students are able to fully engage with teachers as well as with the students in the classroom along with other students who are attending classes online.



Health, safety and wellbeing of students, staff and parents has always been the top priority for BLPS. We are monitoring the developments closely with new research and guidelines coming in, and all decisions will be anchored to the principle of abundant caution.

Online behaviour policy: An online rules and behaviour policy was created that set out student expectations during lessons such as participation, caring for their classmates and not talking over each other, amongst others.
