## IT'S CLIMB THAT MATTERS NOT A MOUNTAIN!



Under the supervision of their Form tutor, our venturesome and audacious adventurers had their climbing sessions. Climbing plays a key role in early childhood motor skills development. Climbing at a young age helps hone spatial and directional



awareness, and also boosts physical skills such as balance, hand and foot coordination, and agility. Climbing a wall teaches children great hand, feet and eye coordination. Kids learnt to look out, plan and then coordinate their hands and feet to get to their chosen spot. It's also a great way to reinforce the understanding of left and right. This activity shall give them the confidence and belief in



them to handle problems in other areas of their life. This is fantastic for building children's planning and problem solving abilities. Climbing teaches them valuable life lessons, and gives them an opportunity to fall in love with the outdoors. Students may struggle with some routes on the school rock climbing wall, but that's ok! They don't have to reach the top on the first try every time. That's part of climbing.



## There is a Maths in a Magic box!

Maths is an important part of learning for children in the early years because it provides vital life skills enabling children to solve problems, measure and develop their own spatial awareness, and learn about shapes. One of the tools that can be allowed for kindergarteners is to play a magic box game that can develop their cognitive knowledge about numbers besides magic box can also develop fine motor skills and how to play exciting interconnected activities like counting, naming words, numbers. The tiny tots participated in magic math box activity. The concept of addition and subtraction was introduced through this activity.

## Dance Moves



Our Preschoolers participated in the freestyle Solo Dance Competition -Preschoolers were assisted by their Instructors. Children often make discoveries through physical actions such as running, playing, and Dancing. The performances were judged for 1) Synchronization, 2) Movements, 3) Rhythm and 4) Poise.

resources for teachers to make learning fun in all subjects!
