May our tricolour always fly high. Let us immerse ourselves in fortifying ourselves academically, living peacefully with each other and progress together as a nation.










School held 'Best Out of Waste Competition 2022' attracting participation by students studying in Grade I to V in which the students assembled recyclable waste into useful articles / decorations.
