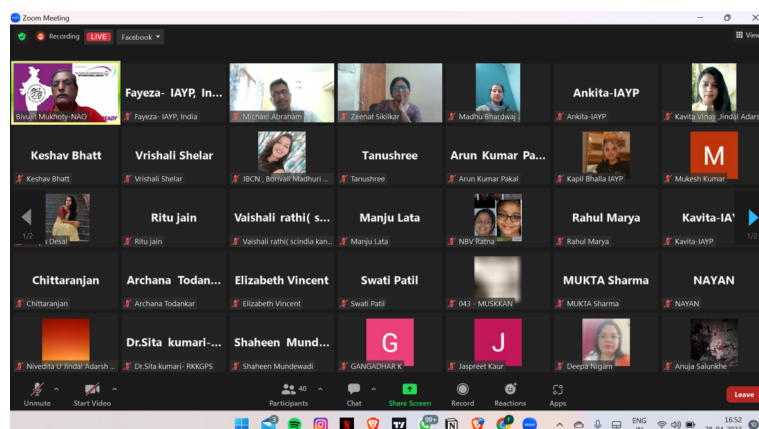
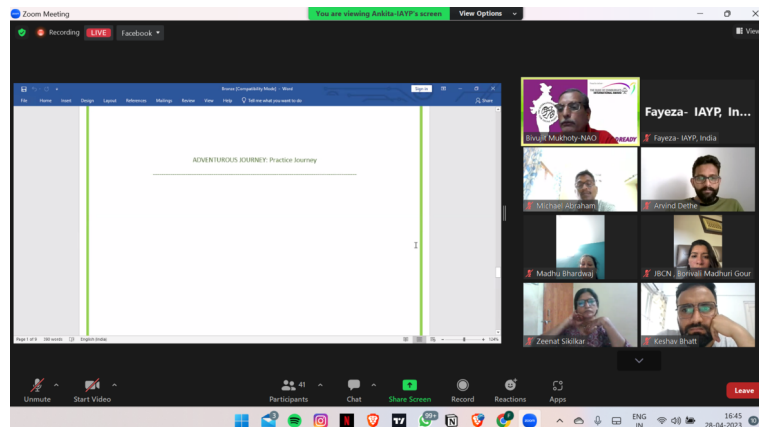
AMA (Ask Me Anything about The Award)

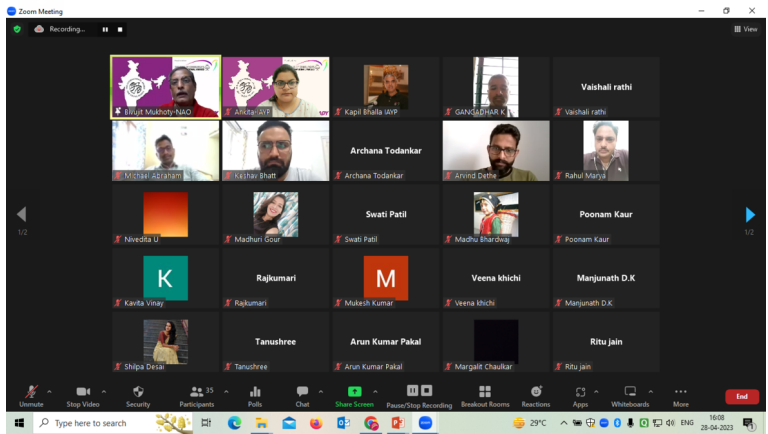
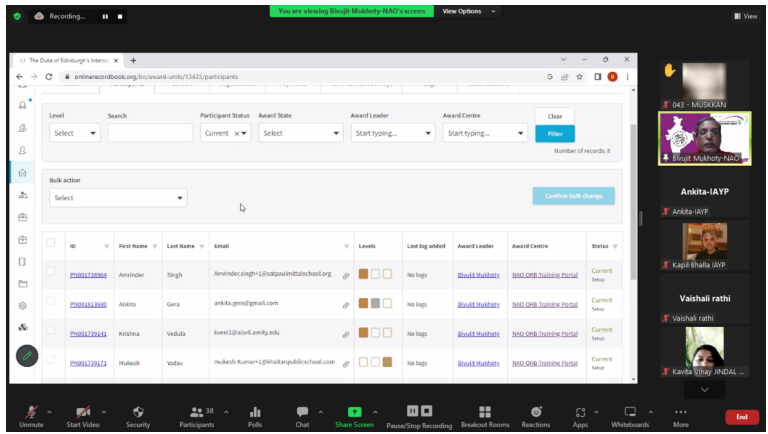
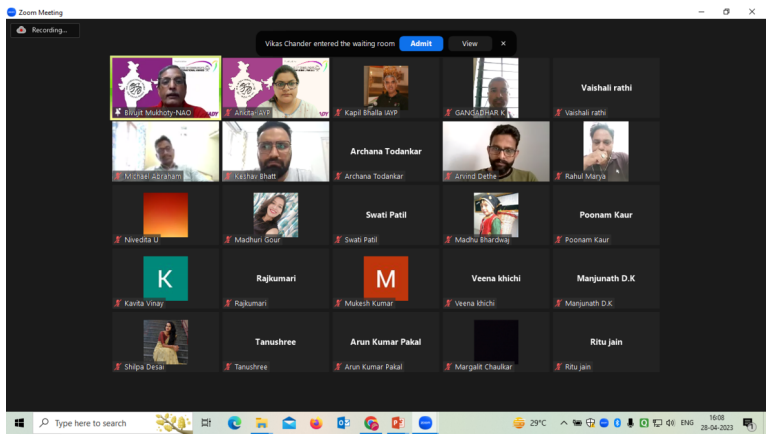
Question: If a participant plays a sport (under the physical recreation section) for one hour, five days a week. Will the hours be counted towards the next week as well?

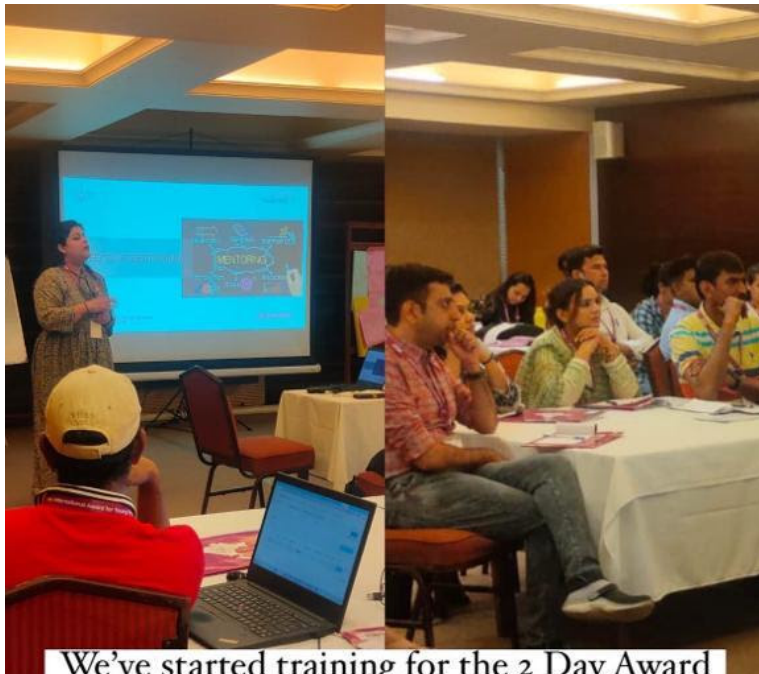
