My experience of doing Seva at State Gurdwara Sahib Kapurthala

I am Tashi Kapoor, an Award participant from Form- IX Adorables, Bawa- Lalvani Public School, Kapurthala. Following is my experience during my visit to Gurdwara Sahib as a part of The Award Programme. It was a pleasure to visit the State Gurdwara Sahib, Kapurthala.

We covered our heads and entered the Gurudwara. We bowed down, took the blessings of Baba ji, and received Karah Prasad. After that, we took a group photo with our classmates.

We then quietly sat for 5-10 minutes in peace, feeling God's presence around us. Then, we participated in seva. We started by sweeping the main path that visitors use to enter the Darbar. We picked up dried leaves and placed them in the dustbin. After that, we swept the floor of the langar hall and ended the day by mopping the langar hall and entry area.

Seva is doing more than expected. The mind tries to understand it but, in my experience, I am realizing that the surface is not chosen consciously but emerges on its own. Additionally, Seva to me looked boring and routine-like but I have now realized that this was just my perspective as in reality, it is an open emotional space to recognize emotions, confront them, and go beyond to see what comes next.

After cleaning, we went to the langar hall for seva and served langar to people sitting there. It was really soothing to help everyone. Then, I cleaned the utensils and felt very blessed. Successful seva is accomplished when you are aware that the recipient of your seva is indeed doing you a service by allowing you to serve them, just as God and the guru do for us when we serve them.

Overall, this visit to the Gurudwara was not just a religious experience but also a lesson in humanity. It reminded us of the importance of selfless service, equality, and compassion in today's world. Our visit to the Gurudwara was surely a humbling and enlightening experience. Notice: Mandatory Submission of Adventure Journey Reports

Dear Participants and Award Leaders, **Effective January 1, 2024**, there is a crucial requirement regarding the documentation of Adventure Journeys.

All participants (online or offline) must upload individual accounts/reports for their Adventure Journey. These reports will be uploaded for online participants under the designated "Additional Files" section on ORB; for semi-offline participants, this should be written in their log sheet before uploading.

- For Bronze and Silver Level Participants: A comprehensive view and account of the Adventure Qualifying Journey is mandatory.
- For Gold Level Participants: Submission of both Practice and Qualifying Journey accounts is compulsory.

Your adherence to this requirement is highly appreciated and will contribute significantly to the continued success of The Award in India.
