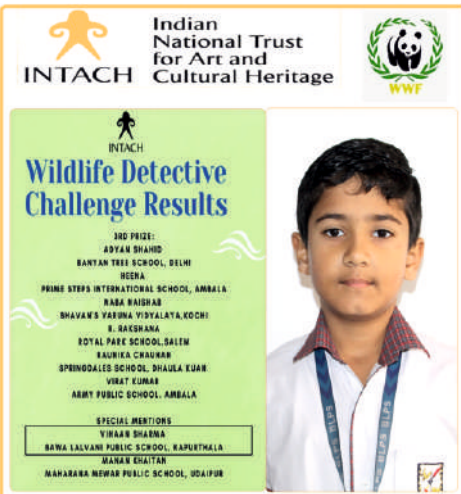


## AS I AM: A JOURNEY OF ARTISTIC GROWTH!
