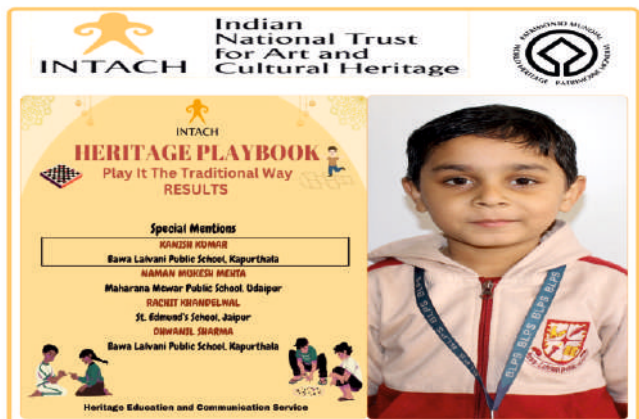


# ACTIVITIES OF THE MONTH
