Important Update on the Adventurous Journey Section as part of The Award Programme

We are excited to announce a flexibility to the Adventure Journey requirements:

-Bronze Level: The **Practice Adventure Journey can be waived if the NAO considers that adequate preliminary training is done, and the requirements of the Adventurous Journey.** This adjustment is aimed at making the Award Programme more accessible and encouraging wider participation at the introductory level.

-Silver & Gold Levels: The **Practice Adventure Journey remains a mandatory component.** Participants at these levels are required to complete The Preliminary Training, the Practice Journey and the Qualifying Journeys to meet the programme's standards.

This change allows participants to focus on enjoying the experience of self discovery from the Adventure Journey experience at Bronze while maintaining the rigor and leadership development elements at Silver and Gold levels.

Our Future India Initiative

The **Our Future India** campaign, led by the **Next Generation India Fellows** (a *UN Foundation & CEEW* initiative), is inviting young people (ages 18–30) to help shape a shared vision for India in 2047.

The campaign is building a youth-led report on five global disruptors: AI, climate change, rapid urbanization, demographic trends, and geopolitical shifts - The goal is to launch the report at the **United Nations General Assembly** (UNGA80) in New York this September, and in Delhi- leading up to **WSSD2** (Second World Summit for Social Development to take place in November in Doha Qatar) and **COP30** (UN Climate Change Conference to take place in November in Belem, Brazil)!

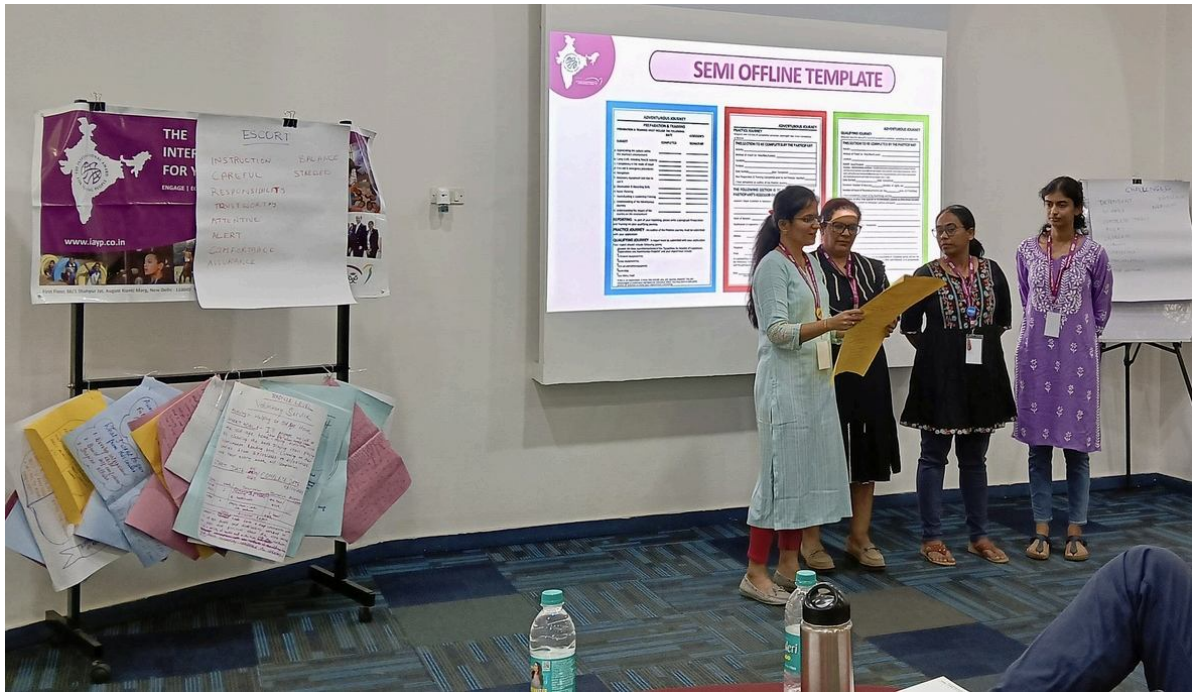
