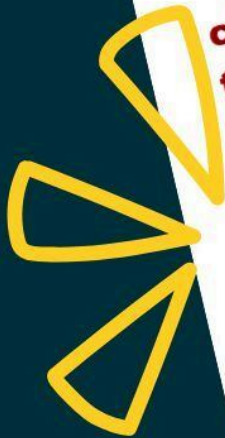

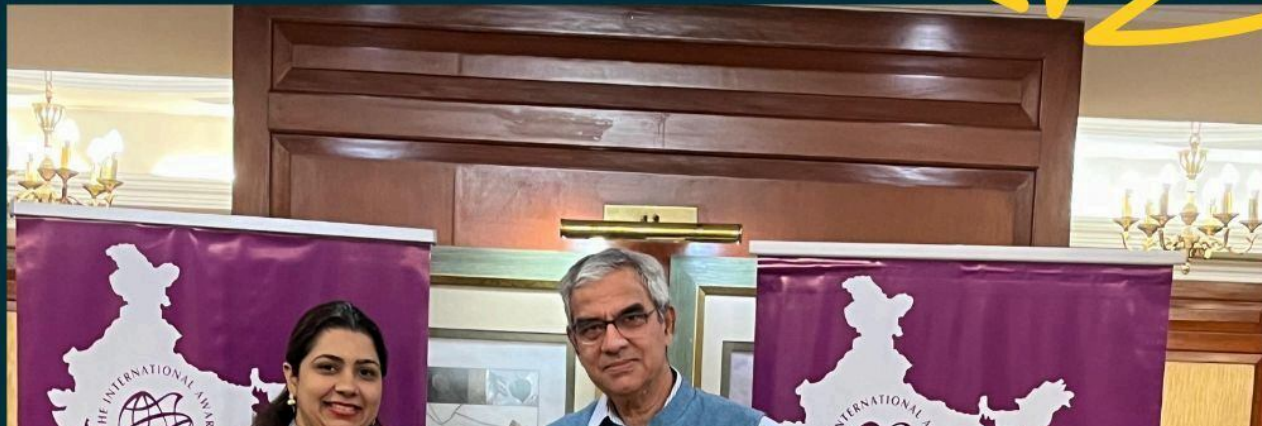


Reflections of an Award Leader

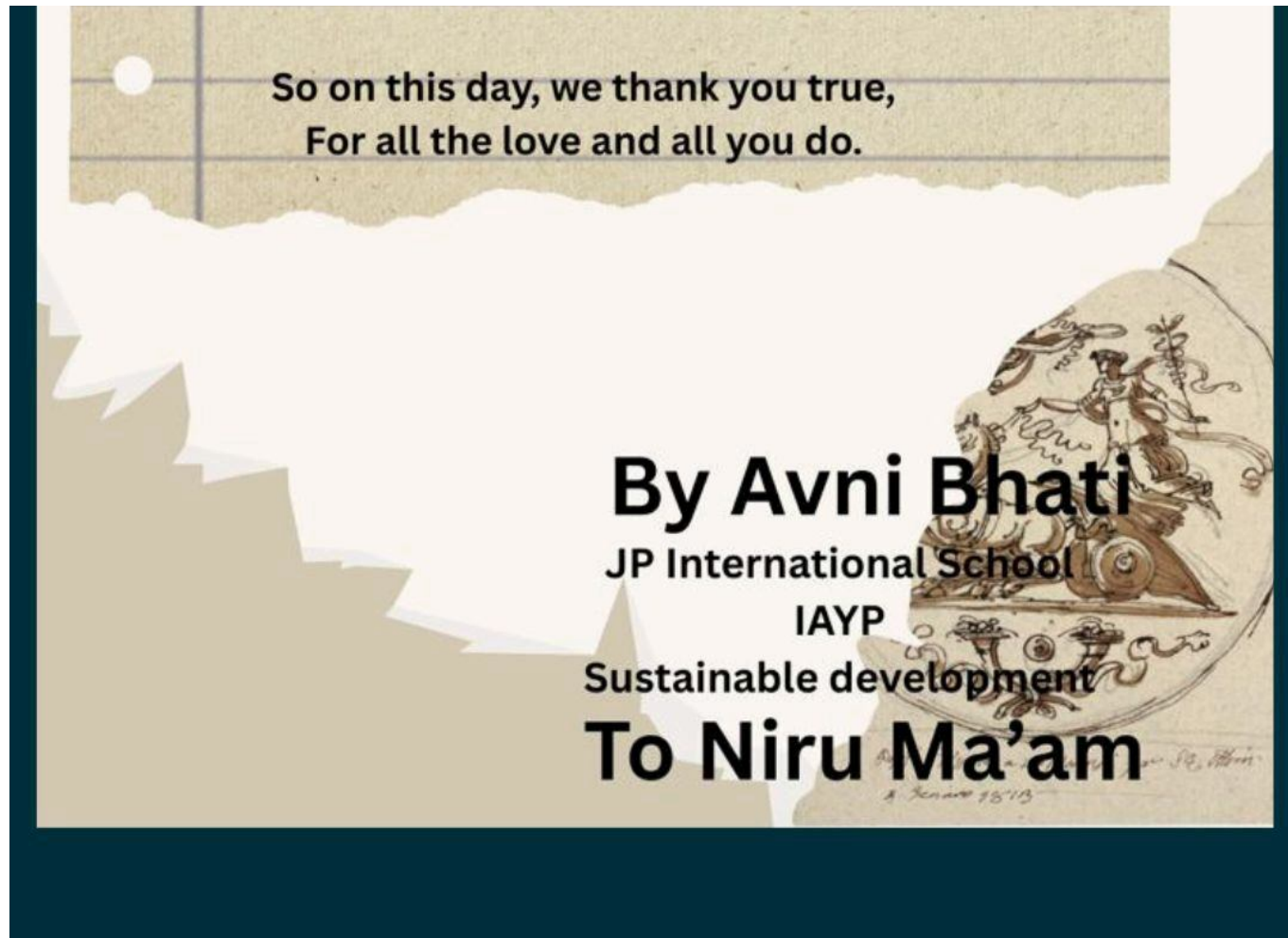


Happy Teacher's Day



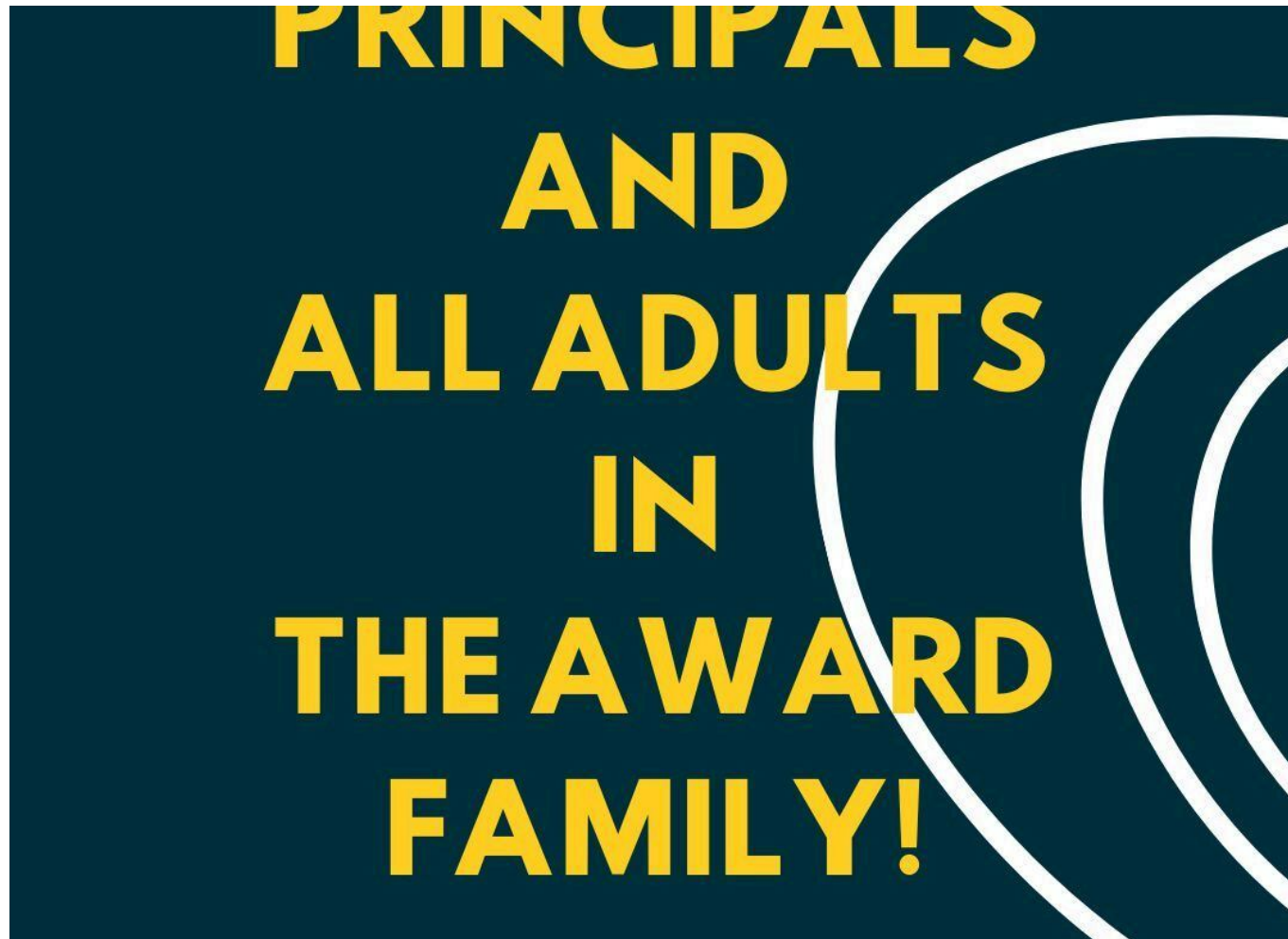
